

Ordinance 1-2018
Passed January 9, 2018

AN ORDINANCE TO CONFIRM THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF TOM HINTZ TO THE POSITION OF ADMINISTRATIVE POLICE CHIEF EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2018, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor's appointment of Tom Hintz to the position of Administrative Police Chief effective January 1, 2018 is confirmed.
2. THAT all compensation and benefits due Tom Hintz as Administrative Police Chief shall commence and be paid from January 1, 2018.
3. THAT the residency requirement for Tom Hintz to reside within the Village of Plymouth, Ohio is waived.
4. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to authorize compensation for this position commencing January 1, 2018, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
