

Ordinance 2-2018
Passed January 23, 2018

AN ORDINANCE TO LEASE THIRTY-FOUR POINT NINE FIVE SEVEN (34.957) ACRES, HAVING PERMANENT PARCEL NUMBERS 23-024A-01-001-0000, 53-0980-A2-059-0000 AND 53-0970-C2-060-0000, EXCLUSIVELY FOR FARMING FOR A TERM OF FIVE (5) YEARS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village owns fifty-three (53) acres of tillable land currently not needed for municipal purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized and directed to lease to the highest bidder the Village-owned Thirty-four point nine five seven (34.957) acres, having Permanent Parcel Numbers 23-024A-01-001-0000, 53-0980-A2-059-0000 AND 53-0970-C2-060-0000, for a five (5) year lease as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT the Fiscal Officer shall advertise the proposed lease once a week for five (5) consecutive weeks.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to provide for the 2018 growing season and best use of the property, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
