

Ordinance 4-2018

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT WITH GUENTHER MECHANICAL, INC OF ASHLAND, OHIO FOR \$104,995 WITHOUT FORMAL BIDDING AND ADVERTISING BY DECLARING A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY EXISTS DUE TO THE FAILURE OF THE VILLAGE HALL BOILERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Hall is the location of daily Village government operations including the Police Department, the location of pre-school education classes; and

WHEREAS, the boiler system has failed and the Village Hall is without a reliable heating source necessary to reasonably insure the necessary daily operations of the Village as well as to provide a safe area to the public in the event of a natural catastrophe; and

WHEREAS, only one (1) area contractor is available to provide immediate boiler replacement at a reasonable cost to the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT pursuant to R.C. 735.051 a real and present emergency has arisen from the failure of the Village Hall's boiler system, which requires immediate replacement.
2. THAT the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Guenther Mechanical, Inc, Ashland Ohio for \$104,955.00 to immediately replace the Village Hall's boiler system according to the terms and conditions approved by Council.
3. THAT That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need of public welfare and safety to replace and provide a reliable boiler system to the Village Hall and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
