Items for discussion tonight are as follows:

- Pool
- Veterans Park
- Basketball Court
- Park and Scout hut

Pool

Administrator Burton reported the guys have been working on the pool. He listed the following:

- Finishing up caulking
- Patching holes in concrete
- Cleaning up the building
- All features are in and turned on
- Will begin painting the bottom of the pool
- Chemicals have been ordered and received
- Water is on in the building

Items left to do:

- Paint bike rack
- Interviewing 4 applicants (received another application today)

Ms. Broderick stated we would need legislation confirming appointment and pay at the next meeting.

Broderick stated the pool hours would be Noon to 7pm daily. Opening day is still scheduled for May 25, 2024.

Broderick stated there are a few items she would like to see done. They are as follows:

- Battery for the lift chair.
 - Rebekah called about this last year. It might not just be the battery, it might be the whole housing unit.
- Pool Sign – Broderick feels we need another one. She would like one that is water resistant and printed on both sides.
 - Jamie will check into this.
- Call about phone service
 - Jamie to check to see if we need phone lines

Broderick asked if the rates have been updated on the website and the signs redone. Rebekah stated they are already done.

Broderick would also still like to have a clean up day, on Saturday, May 18th, if needed. Burton will let her know. It was also suggested if there were only a few things to do, maybe they could go down for a few hours in the evening.

Burton stated he cleaned the filter house.

Broderick stated she touched base with Rebekah about the concession stand.

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Fiscal Officer asked if they wanted to start with the same amount of start money as last year. Broderick stated yes.

Veterans Park

Broderick reported the mulch and new flags are in and up. Burton and Gordon are working on the fountain.

FFA is going to go down and clean up and plant flowers.

Basketball court

Broderick stated the grant for the basketball court was given to Dwayne, he will be taking lead on this.

Mr. Cassidy stated he will contact ODNR tomorrow about the change of contact and an extension on completion.

Park and Scout Hut

Broderick asked if there could be picnic a few picnic tables in the back of the scout hut. It was stated there are some currently back there.

Burton stated he needs to get the handicap ramp done. He would like an 8-foot by 4-foot deck with a ramp and rails.


Broderick asked if he can install the rails on each side of what is currently there.
