A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO SELL UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT VILLAGE PERSONAL PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION IN THE CALENDAR YEAR 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, R.C. 721.15 (D) authorizes the Village to utilize internet auction for the sale of personal property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Plymouth, County of Richland, State of Ohio:

1. That for the calendar year 2021, the Village may sell its unneeded, obsolete or unfit for public use personal property by internet auction.
2. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are directed to contract with GovDeals to provide on behalf of the Village its internet auction and utilizing GovDeals Published Online Sales – Terms and Conditions.
3. That internet bidding shall not be less than fifteen (15) days including Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

Updates shall be posted throughout the year on all Village postings.

5. That notice of the intent to sell property by internet auction shall be published twice, posted continually at the office of the Fiscal Officer and posted continually on the Village's website.
6. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to increase Village revenues and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
