A RESOLUTION TO CONFIRM THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF TOM RUSYNYK TO THE POSITION OF VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS, AND TO WAIVE HIS VILLAGE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has given notice to Council of his appointment of Tom Rusynyk to the position of Village Administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor's appointment of Tom Rusynyk to the position of Village Administrator is approved.
2. THAT his annual compensation shall be \$ 53,400.00. That he shall be entitled to the same benefits of a full-time Village employee. That his Village service shall commence July 16, 2018.
3. THAT Tom Rusynyk is not required to be a Village resident within six (6) months of his appointment and his residence outside the Village is approved.
4. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to fill the vacancy of Village Administrator in order to continue Village Utility and Public Service Operations, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
