A RESOLUTION TO REPEAL SECTION 1 OF RESOLUTION 3-2021 REGARDING CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDING OF THE FOOD PANTRY FOR \$1,000.00 AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT Section 1 of Resolution 3-2021 is amended and shall read:

That the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into a Subgrant Agreement with Romans 12:13 to enable its receipt of Coronavirus Relief Funding in the amount of \$5,658.71.

SECTION 2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to void the Village check # 024167 dated 2/16/2021 for the uncashed \$1,000.00 check to the Food Pantry, and the CRF funds shall be used to offset other COVID-19 expenses and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
