A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COMPENSATION OF PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS AT DOUBLE TIME WHO ACTUALLY WORK DESIGNATED HOLIDAYS, TO REPEAL RESOLUTION 34-2012 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Village Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to compensate part-time police officers at double time of their hourly wage rate who actually work during Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Thanksgiving, Labor Day, Memorial Day and Fourth of July.
2. THAT for calculating the start and finish of each of the above holidays the Fiscal Officer shall use midnight to midnight of each holiday.
3. THAT Resolution 34-2012 is repealed
4. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to encourage part-time police officers to cover those important holidays and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
