A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE APPLICATION AND ORDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) NEW CHEVROLET TAHOE POLICE CRUISERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the time between ordering and delivery of new police cruisers can be up to two years,
and

WHEREAS, it is reasonable to plan now for the anticipated replacement of the Village's existing police cruisers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. To repeal Resolution 5-2024, passed March 12, 2024.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to make application for and sign a purchase order for the Village's purchase of two new Chevrolet 2023 PPV 4x4s.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor may place such purchase order with the Tim Lally Chevrolet dealer in Westerville Heights, Ohio for purchase under the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services local government purchasing in an amount not exceeding \$90,000.00.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason there is an immediate need to timely make order to insure the availability of necessary vehicles, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
