A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO REQUEST FUNDING UNDER THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 FOR NONENTITLEMENT UNITS (NEU) OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND TO APPOINT THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER AS ITS (NEU) FUNDING CONTACT REPRESENTATIVE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to request funding under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 on behalf of the Village as a nonentitlement unit of local government (NEU) and to accept all the terms and conditions of such funding.

SECTION 2. THAT the Fiscal Officer is directed to be the NEU funding contact representative for the purpose of receiving, providing and reporting all required actual budget documents as may be required by the State of Ohio and the U.S. Treasury.

SECTION 3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to make timely request for funding, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
