A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE AND THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR COVERING THE USE OF VILLAGE STREETS FOR MAINTENANCE PURPOSES DURING THE IMPROVEMENT OF RIC-61-12.74 PID 113254 CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT 40(24), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) requires an Agreement regarding the maintenance of the Village of Plymouth's streets during the RIC-61-12.74 PID 113254 Culvert Replacement Project 40(24), and

WHEREAS, ODOT has determined that it is necessary to detour traffic during construction of this improvement, and

WHEREAS, the designated local maintenance route includes roads or streets not under the jurisdiction of ODOT, and

WHEREAS, during the 30 day period that State Route 61 is closed to through traffic, ODOT has agreed to maintain the designated local maintenance route in passable condition and return to the Village of Plymouth as good of a condition as it was prior to its use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Village of Plymouth agrees to continue normal maintenance (i.e., mowing, snow-plowing, etc.) of the below designated route during the time required to complete the proposed improvement, at no cost to the State of Ohio:
 - Traveling Northbound on State Route 61, turn Right/East onto Richland County Road 190/Opdyke Road.
 - Turn Left/North onto Richland County Road 191/Plymouth-Springmill Road, which becomes Spring Mill Road in the Village of Plymouth.
 - Return to State Route 61.
 - The reverse of this route is also included.
2. THAT the Mayor is authorized to sign the ODOT Agreement between the Village and ODOT for the above-referenced culvert replacement.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that the signed Agreement is required by the Ohio Department of Transportation, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.

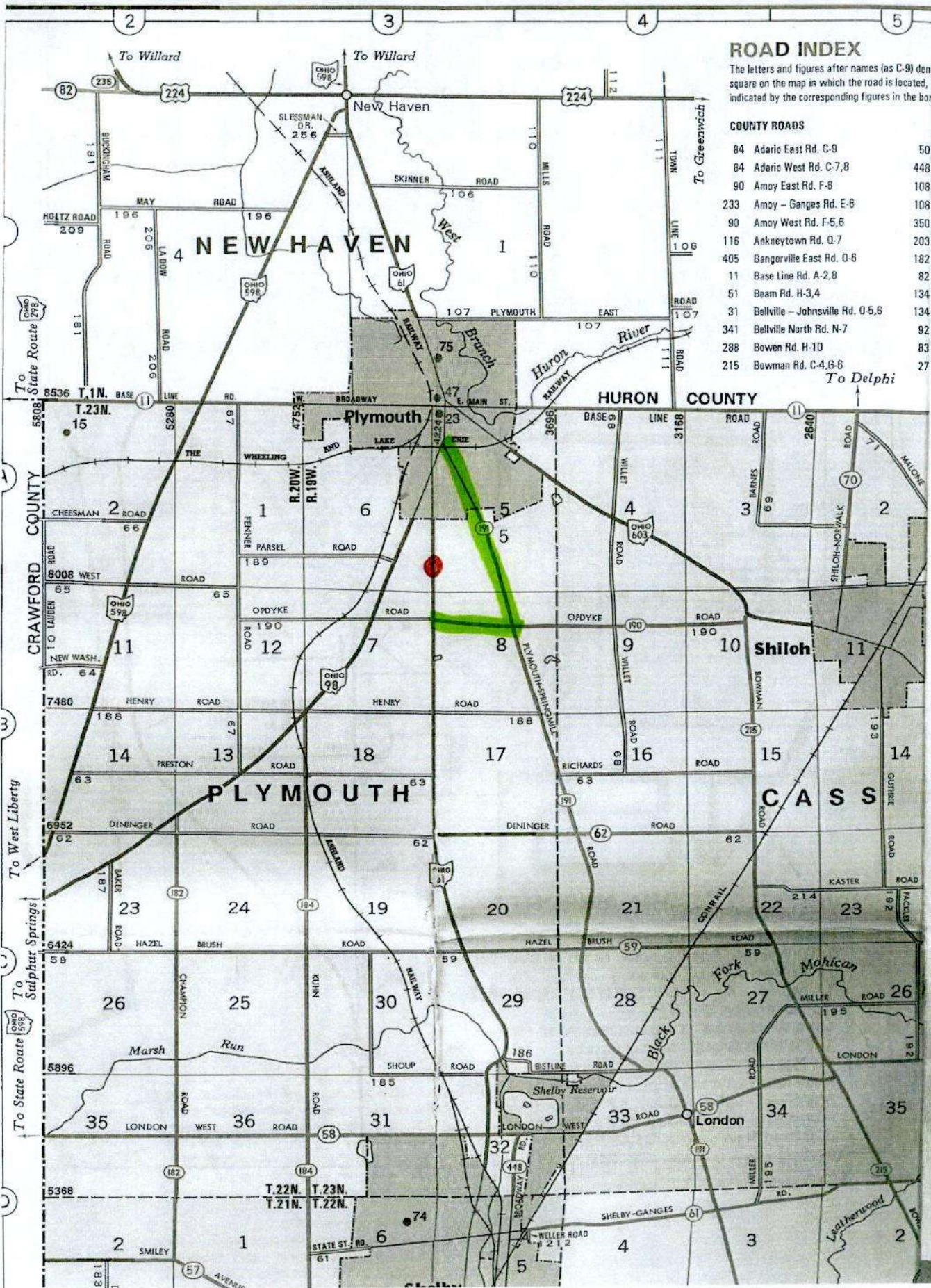

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**AGREEMENT COVERING THE USE OF COUNTY/TOWNSHIP/CITY/VILLAGE STREETS
FOR MAINTENANCE PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio contemplates the improvement of **RIC-61-12.74 PID 113254 Culvert Replacement Project 40(24)**; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation has determined that it is necessary to detour traffic during construction of this improvement; and

WHEREAS, the designated local maintenance route includes roads or streets are not under the jurisdiction of the Director of Transportation, as described below; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation wishes to obtain concurrence of affected authorities prior to establishment of said local maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, during the **30** day period that **State Route 61** is closed to through traffic, the Director of Transportation agrees to maintain this designated local maintenance route in passable condition and return to the **Village of Plymouth** as good of a condition as it was prior to its use.

NOW, THEREFORE, the **Village of Plymouth** agrees to continue his normal maintenance (i.e., mowing, snow-plowing, etc.) of this said designated local maintenance route during the time required to complete the proposed improvement, at no cost to the State of Ohio.

The designated local maintenance detour route will be the following:

- Traveling Northbound on State Route 61, turn Right/East onto Richland County Road 190/Opdyke Road.
- Turn Left/North onto Richland County Road 191/Plymouth-Springmill Road, which becomes Spring Mill Road in the Village of Plymouth.
- Return to State Route 61.
- The reverse of this route is also included.

The **Village of Plymouth** has inspected his portion of the road to be used as a local maintenance route and has reviewed the above agreement and map and concurs in the use as proposed.
