

Resolution 14-2024

A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE THE BALANCE OF \$28,412.98 IN THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACCOUNT FOR VILLAGE POOL MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS DUE TO COVID-19 RELATED REVENUE LOSSES AND TO REPEAL RESOLUTION 12-2023, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village experienced revenue loss in its operation of its Village pool due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and

WHEREAS, the loss also affected or delayed necessary pool maintenance and improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the \$28,412.98 in the American Rescue Plan Account is hereby appropriated for the current and 2024 Village pool maintenance and operations.
2. THAT Resolution 12-2023 is hereby repealed.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to utilize and appropriate American Rescue Plan Account funds within the 2024 fiscal year and continued operation of the pool in 2024 requires the use of such funds due to prior loss of revenues, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
