A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A 2021 ROAD SALT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT WITH THE COMPASS MINERALS FOR 100 TONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH,
COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Assistant Village Administrator and Village Fiscal Officer are authorized to enter into a 2022 Road Salt Participation Agreement with Compass Minerals for the purchase of 100 tons according to the terms of the agreement as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to purchase sufficient road salt for the 2020-2021 season, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
