

Resolution 160-2023

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR AN ADDITIONAL ONE (1) MILL PARKS AND RECREATION LEVY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH,  
COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT this Council determines and declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient and that it is therefore necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Plymouth, Huron/Richland County, Ohio, for the purpose of parks and recreation per R.C. 5705.19(H), at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to Ten Cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation for five (5) years, and which levy is an additional levy of one (1) mill.
2. THAT the question of approving the levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Plymouth, Ohio, at the general election to be held on the 7th day of November, 2023, and that said levy be placed on the tax lists of the tax year commencing in 2023, first due in the calendar year 2024, in compliance with the provisions of R.C. 5705.34, if a majority of the electors voting therein vote in favor thereof.
3. THAT a copy of this Resolution be certified immediately by the Fiscal Officer of this Board to the Richland County Auditor with instructions to calculate and certify to this Council (i) the total current tax valuation of the Village of Plymouth, (ii) the levy's rate, expressed in dollars, rounded to the nearest dollar, for each one hundred thousand dollars of the County Auditor's appraised value, (iii) the dollar amount of revenue, rounded to the nearest dollar, that would be generated by an additional levy of 0.5 mills for each one dollar of taxable value, (iv) and an estimate of the levy's annual collections, rounded to the nearest one thousand dollars, which shall be calculated assuming that the amount of the tax list of the Township remains throughout the life of the levy the same as the amount of the tax list for the current year, and if this is not determined, the estimated amount submitted by the Auditor to the County Budget Commission.
4. THAT it is found and determined that the all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with law.
5. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to timely file this Resolution with the Richland County Board of Elections to place the levy on the November 7, 2023 General Election Ballot, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.


