A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE 2022 MONTHLY TRASH PICK-UP PER CUSTOMER RATE TO \$ 16.75 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has a contract with Rumpke for its municipal trash pick-up, and

WHEREAS, Rumpke has increased in 2022 its service charge, and

WHEREAS, current municipal rates do not cover the cost of the Rumpke contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT commencing with the first 2022 monthly customer billing for Rumpke provided trash pick-up services, the monthly rate shall be \$16.75 for each customer.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to increase the 2022 customer rates to cover the costs of Rumpke services and to avoid a budget deficit and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
