A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF THE TWO VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH POLICE VEHICLES NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES TO ANOTHER PUBLIC ENTITY(ENTITIES), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village owns two used and now obsolete vehicles, to-wit: 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe PPV 4x4 and a 2017 Ford Utility Interceptor, which has a value greater than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has agreed to its sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the Village Administrator is authorized and directed to proceed with the sale of the 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe PPV 4x4 and a 2017 Ford Utility Interceptor Truck to another Public Entity or Public Entities.
2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to obtain the best available price for this used equipment, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
