

Resolution 19-2024

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A MASTER LEASE AGREEMENT WITH NCL GOVERNMENT CAPITAL FOR THE LEASE-PURCHASE OF TWO NEW POLICE VEHICLES FOR VILLAGE USE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its home rule powers granted under Article XVIII, of the Ohio Constitution, the Village council has determined there is an immediate necessity to lease new motor vehicles to replace worn out vehicles, and

WHEREAS, R.C. 133.01 (GG)(2) recognizes Village leases as public obligations, and


WHEREAS, R.C. 133.30 authorizes the private sale of such leases, and

WHEREAS, R.C. 133.20 (B)(8) authorizes motor vehicles leases up to five (5) years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized to enter into the master lease agreement with NCL Government Capital not to exceed the amount of \$ 90,000.00 for the lease-purchase of two new police vehicles for the purpose of municipal service in accordance with the terms and conditions approved by Council
2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to replace worn out Village vehicles in order to provide necessary public service to protect the public safety and welfare, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council
