A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, OHIO TO EXECUTE THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT COMMUNITY PARK, RECREATION/CONSERVATION PROJECT PASS THROUGH GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE PLYMOUTH COMMUNITY POOL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, State of Ohio grants have been identified to help fund a splash pad for Village residents, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Senate Bill No. 310, the 133rd General Assembly of the State of Ohio has appropriated funds in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) to make a grant to the Village of Plymouth, Ohio for the costs associated with the construction of a park and recreation or conservation facility, described as "Plymouth Community Pool."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor of the Village of Plymouth, Ohio is hereby authorized to execute the Capital Improvement Community Park, Recreation/Conservation Project Pass Through Grant Agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate necessity to sign the Agreement to receive the grant funding, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
