

Resolution 21-2023

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY AN ADDITIONAL 1.0 MILL TAX FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARKS AND RECREATION IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY [R.C. 5705.19(H)].

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of May, 2023, Council adopted a Resolution determining to submit to the electors of the Village of Plymouth, Ohio, described below, a copy of which Resolution was certified to the County Auditor of Richland County; and

WHEREAS, the County Auditor has certified to this Council that the total current tax evaluation of the Village of Plymouth is \$22,580,460.00, and the dollar amount of revenue that will be produced annually by the millage stated below would be \$22,580.00. The millage for the requested levy is 1.0 mill per \$1.00 of taxable value, which amounts to \$35.00 for each \$100,000.00 of the County Auditor's appraised value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Plymouth, County of Richland, State of Ohio:

1. That this Council desires and determines to proceed with the submission to the electors of the question of levying a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Plymouth, Richland and Huron Counties, Ohio, for the purpose of Parks and Recreation pursuant to R.C. 5705.19(H) at a rate not exceeding one (1.0) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation for five (5) years, and which levy is an additional tax levy of one (1.0) mill.
2. That the question of approving the levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Plymouth at the election to be held on the 7th day of November, 2023 and that said levy be placed on the tax lists of the current tax year, commencing in 2023, first due in the calendar year 2024, in compliance with the provisions of O.R.C. 5705.34, if a majority of the electors voting therein vote in favor thereof.
3. That the Fiscal Officer of this Village is directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections of Richland County, Ohio, not less than ninety days before the election, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
4. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to provide for continued maintenance and operation of the Village Parks and Recreation and to timely file with the Board of Elections, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.


