
A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER DIANN JAMERSON AS THE VILLAGE'S RECORD MANAGER EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 10, 2021 AND TO REPEAL RESOLUTION 11-2019 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Rebekah Fearing is taking a new position with the Village and can no longer serve as the Village's Public Records Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT commencing November 10, 2021 Village Fiscal Officer DiAnn Jamerson is the Village's Public Records Manager as provided by R.C. 149.43..
2. THAT Resolution 11-2019 is repealed.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to have a current Village Public Records Manager and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council


