

RESOLUTION NO. 23-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO REGARDING THE COUNTY'S RECEIPT OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT IDENTIFIED AS CDBG-C1 FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR THE WEST BROADWAY STORM AND STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF

PLYMOUTH, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Board of County Commissioners of Richland County, Ohio regarding the County's receipt of the Community Development Block Grant Critical Infrastructure Grant identified as CDBG-C1 from the Ohio Department of Development for their assistance with the West Broadway Storm and Street Improvement Project.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate necessity that the CDBG-C1 Agreement be signed and returned to Richland County by November 10, 2021 in order to allow the project construction to timely proceed, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
