A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE FINAL APPOINTMENT OF CHRISTOPHER ANDRUS AND KATIE SHAFER AS REGULAR FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Christopher Andrus and Katie Shafer have successfully completed the six (6) month probationary period and the Mayor has recommended their Final Appointment as Village Police Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT Council concurs with the Mayor's recommendation that Christopher Andrus and Katie Shafer are given their Final Appointment as regular full-time Village Police Officers effective July 23, 2023 with hourly compensation of Twenty-One Dollars (\$21.00).
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to provide adequate full-time police protection within the Village, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
