A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TIMECLOCKPLUS, LLC FOR TIME KEEPING SERVICES FOR VILLAGE OFFICES AND TO ASSIGN THE COST THEREOF TO THE VARIOUS OFFICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to enter into the 48-month lease with TimeClockPlus, LLC for employee time keeping services for Village offices with an annual cost of \$2,400.00 according to the terms and conditions reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT the Fiscal Officer shall assign the cost and payment to the following Village offices in accordance with the below stated percentages:
  1. Fire 40 %
  2. Police 25 %
  3. Village Administration 35 %
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to provide efficient time keeping for Village employees to provide and schedule adequate public services and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
