A RESOLUTION APPOINTING REBEKAH FEARING TO THE POSITION OF TAX/MAYOR COURT CLERK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is a vacancy in the position of Tax/Mayor Court Clerk and,

WHEREAS, Rebekah Fearing has the needed experience to perform the duties of that position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT commencing November 28, 2021 Rebekah Fearing is appointed to the position of Tax/Mayor Court Clerk.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to fill the vacant position in order to continue Village business without interruption, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
