A RESOLUTION TO CONFIRM THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF MARC RODRIGUEZ TO THE POSITION OF PROBATIONARY FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH,
COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor's appointment of Marc Rodriguez to the position of Probationary full-time police officer is confirmed.
2. THAT the confirmation shall be contingent on their respective approval of the required Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund physical examination. Upon notice of such approval, their duties shall commence at the beginning of the next pay period following approved Physical examination.
3. THAT the hourly compensation for each officer shall be Twenty-One Dollars (\$21.00).
4. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to provide for replacement police protection, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
