

Resolution 26-2021

A RESOLUTION FINDING THE VILLAGE HAS CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY HAVING AN ESTIMATED VALUE GREATER THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) AND AUTHORIZING THEIR SALE BY THE VILLAGE'S ACCOUNT ON GOVDEALS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, the Village has two used dump trucks, plow, 1979 Ford pickup, Hummer vehicle, and fire brush truck having estimated values exceeding \$1,000.00 and which are no longer needed for Village purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to sell through the Village's GovDeals account the two used dump trucks, plow, 1979 Ford pickup, Hummer vehicle, and Fire brush truck.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is a necessity to sell the said property in order to obtain the highest price and to prevent their deterioration, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
