A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A CHANGE ORDER TO THE WEST BROADWAY STREET DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT CONTRACT BY AN ADDITIONAL \$149,656.30 FOR THE ADDITIONAL NEW PAVEMENT OF APPROXIMATELY 3,100 FEET OF WEST BROADWAY STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH,
COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized and directed to execute the Change Order with Ed Burdue & Company for the West Broadway Street Drainage Improvement Contract for an additional \$149,656.30 for the additional new pavement of approximately 3,100 feet of West Broadway Street.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to economically utilize the construction for the needed additional paving while it is already on-site, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
