

Resolution 29-2023

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT OWNERSHIP OF THE WEST BROADWAY STREET BRIDGE UPON APPROVAL OF THE BRIDGE RECONSTRUCTION GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement for the replacement of the West Broadway Street bridge, and

WHEREAS, the Village had agreed to take ownership of the bridge upon completion of the reconstruction, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has conditioned the grant award on the Village taking ownership of the bridge immediately upon ODOT's approval of the grant.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH,
COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to accept ownership of the West Broadway Street bridge from Ashland Railway, Inc. immediately upon the approval and award by ODOT to the Village of the Bridge Reconstruction Grant.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to timely obtain the ODOT grant in order to replace the bridge in the public's interest and welfare, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
