A RESOLUTION TO CONTRACT WITH THE MUNICIPAL ENERGY SERVICES AGENCY FOR CIRCUIT RIDER SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village owned and operates its own electrical system, and

WHEREAS, the Village from time to time needs supplemental technical services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to enter into the Master Services Agreement with the Municipal Energy Services Agency for Circuit Rider Services as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT the approval is for the 2020 calendar year and shall renew annually thereafter unless terminated by Council.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to provide such technical services to maintain uninterrupted services to Village electrical users and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it received a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
