

Resolution 3-2021

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO SUBGRANT AGREEMENTS WITH ROMANS 12:13 AND THE FOOD PANTRY TO MAKE AVAILABLE FUNDING UNDER THE CARES ACT AND CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND DUE TO THEIR COVID-19 NECESSARY EXPENSES TO REPEAL RESOLUTION 35-2020, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Romans 12:13 and Food Pantry have incurred extraordinary expenses in 2020 due to the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, both non-profit organizations have provided much needed relief to the public who have experienced hardships because of the COVID-19 public health emergency, and

WHEREAS, the CARES Act authorizes Council to enter into Subgrant Agreements with certain non-profits to enable them to receive funding for their expenses incurred during the COVID-19 public health emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into Subgrant Agreements with Romans 12:13 and Food Pantry to enable their respective receipt of Coronavirus Relief Funding in the amounts of \$5,658.71 and \$1,000.00.
2. THAT Resolution 35-2020 is repealed.
3. THAT this Resolution is determined to be an emergency Resolution for the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason these payments are immediately necessary to provide for year-end funding of these organizations and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
