A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE OHIO EPA FOR A GRANT FUNDING THE PURCHASE OF AN EMERGENCY GENERATOR AND ACCESSORY EQUIPMENT FOR THE VILLAGE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA accepts Grant Applications to provide equipment to ensure the operational capacity of the Village water distribution system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Village Administrator is authorized to make an Ohio EPA Grant Application to fund the purchase of a generator and accessory equipment to power and operate the Village water distribution system in the event of an emergency at a cost not exceeding \$75,000.00.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is a necessity to timely confirm the submittal of a Grant Application, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
