A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN ANNUAL CONTRACT WITH THE PLYMOUTH-SHILOH LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PROVIDE A VILLAGE POLICE RESOURCE OFFICER DURING ALL STUDENT SCHOOL DAYS DURING THE 2023-2024, 2024-2025 AND 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEARS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor and Village Fiscal Officer are authorized to enter into an annual contract with the Board of Education of the Plymouth-Shiloh Local School District to provide a Village Police Resource Officer for all student school days during the 2023-2024, 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 school years upon the annual payment of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00).
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate necessity to provide uninterrupted and continuing Police Resource Officers as needed by agreement, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
