A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT  
WITH LIFE FIRST AMBULANCE DISTRICT, AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Plymouth Fire Chief has recommended that it would be in the public interest  
to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement with Life First Ambulance District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor and Fire Chief are authorized and directed to enter into the Mutual Aid  
Emergency Medical Service Agreement with Life First Ambulance District as reviewed  
and approved by Council.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary  
for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this  
Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to improve the  
Village's emergency ambulance capabilities, and this Resolution shall therefore go into  
immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to  
this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority  
vote of Council.
