


Resolution 31-2019

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A TWELVE (12) MONTH MASTER SOFTWARE AGREEMENT WITH IMAGE TREND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to enter into the twelve (12) month master software and services agreement with Image Trend according to the terms and conditions reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT the Village Fire Chief shall administer this Agreement on behalf of the Village.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason that there is an immediate need for the software by the Village's Fire Department, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.


