A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, DIVISION OF FORESTRY FOR WILDLAND FIRE SUPPRESSION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to enter into the Cooperative Agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry for the Village's Fire Department participation according to the terms and conditions therein.
2. THAT the Village's Fire Chief is designated as the Village's official to function as the liaison between the Village Fire Department and the Ohio Division of Forestry.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to complete this agreement during the Council 2019 year end meeting, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
