A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE AWARD FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ONE HUNDRED (100%) PERCENT FUNDING OF THE WEST BROADWAY STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT KNOWN AS THE BASELINE ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT (SFN 3946711) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by letter dated October 12, 2023, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) awarded One Hundred (100%) Percent funding for the replacement of the West Broadway Street Bridge Replacement under the Baseline Road Bridge Replacement Project (SFN 3946711), and

WHEREAS, the grant award is contingent on the Village providing written acceptance of the awarded Municipal Bridge Funds by November 30, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the ODOT award of Municipal bridge Funds under the Baseline Road Bridge Replacement Project (SFN 3946711) is accepted and the Mayor is authorized and directed to provide written acceptance of the said award by November 30, 2023.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to provide written acceptance of the award by no later than November 30, 2023, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
