


Resolution 33-2020


A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE RICHLAND COUNTY AUDITOR CERTIFY TO COUNCIL THE CURRENT TAX VALUATION FOR THE SIX (6.0) MILLS CURRENT EXPENSES PER R.C. 5705.19(A) RENEWAL LEVY PURSUANT TO R.C. 5705.03(B) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Plymouth, County of Richland, State of Ohio:

1. That this Council determines and declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient and that it is therefore necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Plymouth, Ohio, for the purpose of Village Current Expenses per R.C. 5705.19(A) at a rate not exceeding six (6.0) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to sixty cents (\$0.60) for each one hundred dollars of valuation for five (5) years, and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy.
2. That the question of approving the levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Plymouth, Ohio at the election to be held on May 4, 2021 and that said levy shall be placed on the tax lists of the current tax year, commencing in 2021, first due in the calendar year 2022, in compliance with the provisions of R.C. 5705.34, if a majority of the electors voting therein vote in favor thereof.
3. That the Fiscal Officer of this Council is directed to certify immediately a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor of Richland County requesting that the County Auditor certify to this Council the total current tax valuation of the Village of Plymouth, Ohio and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the six (6.0) mills levy.
4. That Resolution 27-2020 is repealed.
5. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to timely notice the County Auditor in order to adopt the required Resolution for placement on the May 4, 2021 primary ballot and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.


