A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS TO THE INTERSECTION OF SANDUSKY STREET (S.R. 61) AND MARY FATE PARK DRIVE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of August 2022, the Village enacted legislation proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation for the described project:

The project consists of improvements to the intersection of Sandusky Street (S.R. 61) and Mary Fate Park Drive, including payment planning, resurfacing, and pavement markings, as well as sidewalk, curb ramp, and signing upgrades, lying within the Village of Plymouth, and

WHEREAS, the Village shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above-described project as follows:

The Village agrees to assume and bear One Hundred Percent (100%) of the entire cost of the improvement within the Village limits, less the amount of State funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from allocated funds.

In view of the fact that the Village's share of the project is now estimated in the amount of Zero and - - - 00/100 Dollars, (\$0.00), therefore, the Village will not be required to deposit any funds at this time. The Village's ultimate share of the cost will be determined when final actual costs and allocations are determined, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above-described highway and has transmitted copies of same to this legislative authority, and

WHEREAS, this legislative authority desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Village hereby requests the Director of transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.
2. THAT the Village enter into a contract with the State, and that the Administrator be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contract for improving the described project.
3. THAT the Village transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this Resolution.

4. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to contract for the completion of this much needed improvement and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
5. This is to certify that we have compared the foregoing copy of Resolution with the original record thereof, found in the record of the proceedings of the Village, and which Resolution was duly passed by the Village on the 24th day of October 2023, and that the same is a true and correct copy of the record of said Resolution and the action of said Village thereon.

We further certify that said Resolution and the action of said Village thereon is recorded in the journal of said Village in Volume 2023, at Resolution number 34-2023, and under date of October 24, 2023.
