A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE SCHOOL FLASHER IMPROVEMENTS ALONG STATE ROUTE 603 IN COOPERATION WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State has identified the need for the following described project:

*To perform School flasher improvements on State Route 603 at SLM 20.99 to SLM 21.20 (In front of Plymouth Local Schools) within the Village of Plymouth in Huron County.*

*The project is currently scheduled to be constructed in the summer of 2024.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

**1. Consent Statement**

Being in the public interest, the Village gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

**2. Cooperation Statement**

The Village shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

- A) *The Village gives consent for the above improvement.*
- B) ***No funds are required from the Village** except that the Village agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost for added construction items requested by the Village and not necessary for the improvement as determined by the State and the Federal Highway Administration.*

**3. Maintenance**

Upon completion of the above described project, and unless otherwise agreed, the Village shall:

- A) *Provide adequate maintenance for the above described project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law;*
- B) *Provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the above described project;*
- C) *Maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.*

**4. Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement**

If Village-owned utilities, within a corporation limit or in a private easement outside corporation limits, need to be relocated due to this ODOT project, the Village will be reimbursed for any relocation work; ODOT will perform the coordination, relocation,

and reimbursement which shall comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

If other public and private utilities need to be relocated due to this ODOT project, they will not be reimbursed for relocation; with exceptions due to an easement, etc.

**5. Authority to Sign**


The Village Administrator of the Village of Plymouth is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of Plymouth to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

**6. Emergency**

That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to expedite the highway project and to promote highway safety for school children, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
