A RESOLUTION TO REDUCE THE 2025 MONTHLY TRASH PICK-UP PER CUSTOMER RATE TO \$ 18.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has entered a new contract with Rumpke for its municipal trash pick-up, and

WHEREAS, Rumpke's new contract has reduced the service charge for 2025, and

WHEREAS, the reduced municipal rates will cover the cost of the Rumpke contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT commencing with the first 2025 monthly customer billing for Rumpke provided trash pick-up services, the monthly rate shall be \$18.00 for each customer.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to decrease the 2025 customer rates of Rumpke services and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
