A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT AND UTILIZE THE UNIFORM ACCOUNTING NETWORK (UAN) SERVICE TO GENERATE NOTIFICATION TO COUNCIL IN THE EVENT COMPLETE BANK RECONCILIATION IS NOT POSTED BY THE FISCAL OFFICER WITHIN THE UAN'S REQUIRED 60 DAY POSTING REQUIREMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Ohio Auditor of States eServices account services available through its Uniform Accounting Network (UAN) is accepted and adopted to generate notification to Council if the Fiscal Officer does not post a complete bank reconciliation in UAN within the recommended sixty (60) days posting period.
2. THAT the Fiscal Officer shall give notice of Council's "opt-in" to the Ohio Auditor of States UAN eServices bank reconciliation notification.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to give notice to the Ohio Auditor of States to implement his eService for bank reconciliation and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
