A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO THE SCHEDULE TO MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN SAFETY AND TRAINING PROGRAMS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village is a customer of American Municipal Power, Inc. (AMP), and

WHEREAS, providing safety and training programs to Village employees is a benefit and in the best interests of the Village and its employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into the schedule to Master Services Agreement for participation in safety and training programs as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason there is an immediate need to accept and schedule such safety and training opportunities for the Village's employees, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
