
A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE PAYMENT OF \$3,281.18 TO CUMMINS SALES AND SERVICES FOR FAILED SWITCH BOARD AT THE FILTER HOUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Council is required to approve the certification of funds for a prior Village purchase from Cummins Sales and Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Plymouth, County of Richland/Huron, State of Ohio:

1. That Council approves and authorizes the Fiscal Officer to make payment of \$3,281.18 and the certification of funds for such payment to Cummins Sales and Services for failed switchboard at the filter house.
2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency Resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to authorize payment of this debt and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.


