A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PLYMOUTH-SHILOH LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT APPLICATION FOR SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Plymouth-Shiloh Local School District is making application for a safe routes to school project funding through the Ohio Department of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT Council supports the application of the Board of Education of the Plymouth-Shiloh Local School District in its application for safe routes to school project funding through the Ohio Department of Transportation, and
2. THAT all expenditures for this project will be from awarded STRS funds from the Ohio Department of Transportation and/or the Board of Education, and
3. THAT That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that the Board of Education has an immediate need to timely make the grant application, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
