A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR'S ACCEPTANCE OF THE OHIO EPA EMERGENCY GENERATOR EQUIPMENT GRANT AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THE GENERATOR AND TO REQUEST REIMBURSEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator's Ohio EPA grant application for an Emergency Generator Equipment Grant has been approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Ohio EPA Emergency Generator Equipment Grant Award is accepted.
2. THAT the Village Administrator is authorized to proceed with the purchase of Emergency Generator Equipment and Accessories at a cost not exceeding \$130,000 and to timely request reimbursement from the Ohio EPA.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate necessity to provide for emergency operations of the Village's public water system, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
