A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OPTIMAX FOR MOWING VILLAGE CEMETERIES IN THE 2018 MOWING SEASON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need to provide ongoing mowing of the Village cemeteries during the 2018 grass growing season.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized to enter into a contract with Optimax for the remaining 2018 grass growing season until such mowing is no longer needed at a weekly contract cost of Five Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$590.00).
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to maintain the Village cemeteries by not using Village employees who are needed for other municipal duties, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
