A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE 2018 SALE OF UNNEEDED AND/OR OBSOLETE VILLAGE PERSONAL PROPERTY BY THE INTERNET AUCTION GOVDEALS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has approved the use of internet auction by GovDeals to sell its unneeded and/or obsolete personal property, and

WHEREAS, R.C. 721.15(D) authorizes the Village to utilize internet auction for the sale of personal property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the unneeded and/or obsolete personal property listed in EXHIBIT A and attached hereto is authorized to be sold by internet auction through GovDeals in accordance with the publication and notice procedures of R.C. 721.15(D).
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need not to delay the required notices to the public prior to the auction, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.


