A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE A NEEDED POLICE VEHICLE UNDER THE STATE OF OHIO'S PROCUREMENT AUTHORITY OF O.R.C. 125.04 FROM TIM LALLY CHEVROLET INC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village is a participant in the State of Ohio Procurement Program authorized by R.C. 125.04, and

WHEREAS, the Village's Police Department has an immediate need to replace a police cruiser.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT the Mayor is authorized to purchase through Ohio's R.C. 125.04 Procurement Plan the following:

A new Chevrolet 2020 Tahoe PPV 4x4 for \$37,782.60 from Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc. for the Police Department's use with GM Financial financing.

SECTION 2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason that there is an immediate need for the vehicle and because it is now available under Ohio's Procurement Program, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
