A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE HOURLY COMPENSATION FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT POSITIONS OF FULL-TIME CAPTAIN; FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICERS; PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS AND TO INCREASE YEARLY UNIFORM ALLOWANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH,  
COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT commencing July 29, 2018 the hourly compensation for full-time captain, Montel Gordon shall be \$ 21.40.
2. THAT commencing July 29, 2018 the hourly compensation for all part-time police officers shall be fourteen (\$14.00) dollars.
3. THAT commencing July 29, 2018 the hourly compensation for all full-time police officers successfully completing their probationary period shall be sixteen (\$16.00) dollars.
4. THAT commencing with the 2018 calendar year and each year thereafter the annual uniform allowance paid to Village police officers shall be as follows:
  - (a) All full-time officers \$600.00
  - (b) Eligible part-time officers \$200.00
5. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to compensate police officers in keeping with competitive wage scales, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council
