A RESOLUTION TO CONFIRM THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF WENDI POSTEMA TO THE POSITION OF PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor's appointment of Wendi Postema to the position of part-time Police Officer effective October 7, 2018 at an hourly rate of Fourteen Dollars (\$14.00) is confirmed and approved.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to provide an adequate number of police officers to provide consistent police protection within the Village, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
